Diseases Of The Ureter There may be obstructions due to congenital atresia or to various diseases and neoplasms. The result of such a condition is a dilatation of the ureter above the obstruction and of the kidney (hydronephrosis).

the ureters into the bladder, but it does not flow passively. The ureters push each small amount of urine along in waves of contraction, at low pressure. At the bladder, each ureter passes through an opening in the bladder wall, which closes when the bladder contracts to prevent urine from flowing back
