For example: You could say, "I met Joan." In this sentence the word Joan is a noun. You could replace Joan with a group of words (a phrase) and say, "I met your sister." Your sister is a phrase (a group of words without a finite verb), and it functions as a noun in the sentence. So we call it a noun phrase.
